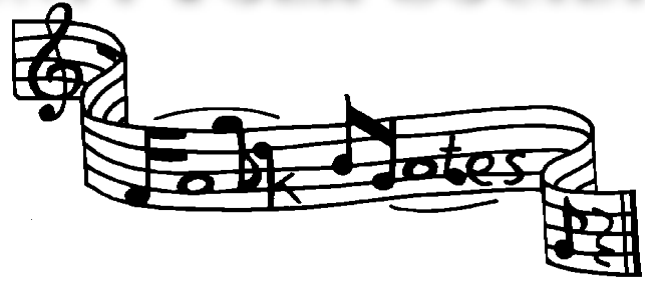

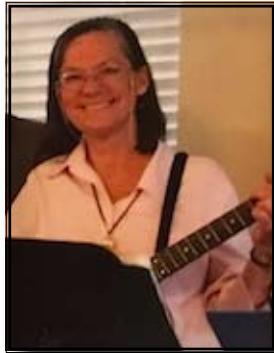

Terry Drury 1953-2017



We have lost a very dear and valued friend. Too quickly, too soon.



The call came the evening of May 22 from our good and mutual friend David Henry. That day Terry had had a massive stroke due to an inoperable brain aneurysm. We hurried to Kaiser Hospital, but there was no need to hurry.

Terry was in ICU with many friends and co-workers around with nothing really to do but say and think our thoughts and prayers, hoping, believing perhaps, that somehow she could hear us and know we were there for her.

With her family, husband Dennis, daughter Jesse, her brothers and sister, we kept visiting throughout the week that Terry was on life support, waiting until all had gathered and decisions made.

On Friday, May 26th, Terry's 64th birthday, she was taken off life support, and allowed to move on.

Terry was a unique and valuable part of the Sebastopol community:

- A charter member of the Love Choir along with Jim Mr. Music" Corbett, and President of the Mr. Music Foundation.
- A mainstay of the Sonoma County Singers Circle, and Mary's Idea, a musical group dedicated to providing entertainment at senior facilities.
- For 28 years, a remarkable, talented, and much-loved kindergarten teacher at Oak Grove School.

Terry was a cheerful, happy, giving person, bringing her gifts of music and joy to all who knew her. She loved to play guitar and sing with others, including some whimsical songs she wrote.

On The Passing of Rosalie Sorrels

Rosalie Sorrels died Sunday June 11, at the age of 83, at her daughter Holly Marizu's home in Reno, Nevada. She had been in failing health for several years.

A number of obituaries have appeared, in the New York Times and other places telling about her life, her travels, and her love of writing and singing folk music. Rosalie was a master storyteller. What we can add are memories of Rosalie during her visits to Sonoma County. She was a cherished regular for many years, along with Bruce "Utah" Phillips, at the Kate Wolf Festival, and before that at the Sonoma County Folk Society's Festivals held at the Luther Burbank Center during the 1990's. Over the years, she made several visits to our local KRCB Radio Folk Music Show, "Our

Fiddle Music at the Heirloom Expo



Santa Rosa's National Heirloom Exposition in September is for the third time sponsoring an Old-Time Fiddling competition as part of its entertainment.

District 10 of the California State Old-Time Fiddlers' Association has taken hand of organizing the competition, and has come up with the most fun and entertaining type of contest around. Called the "\$1000 Fiddle-Off", it is a test not so much of skill, than of fiddling experience.

All the contestants appear simultaneously on stage, and take turns drawing titles of fiddle tunes randomly out of a container. Each contestant must play the tune picked, or must leave the stage. A fiddler with a well-rounded repertoire has the best chance of winning the first prize of \$400 plus a new fiddle, case, and bow.

The enjoyment for both contestants and audience in the Fiddle-Off comes from the contestants wondering if they will draw a tune they know how to play, and from the audience wondering if the individual fiddler will be able to come through. Overall, a wide range of fiddle music is played, and everyone has fun. Besides the first prize, there are cash and merchandise prizes for all contestants. There is also a youth division for younger players.

The Fiddle-Off will be held at the National Heirloom Exposition on Thursday, September 7, 2017, at the Sonoma County Fairgrounds in Santa Rosa, from 2 to 5 p.m. There will be music on stage both before and after the competition, as well.

The Heirloom Expo is a wonderful event featuring heirloom varieties of garden vegetables and fruits, and supporting sustainable production of food in America. It is held annually in Santa Rosa, and draws exhibitors from the entire USA.

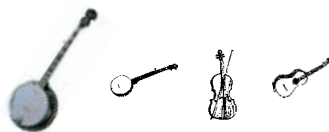

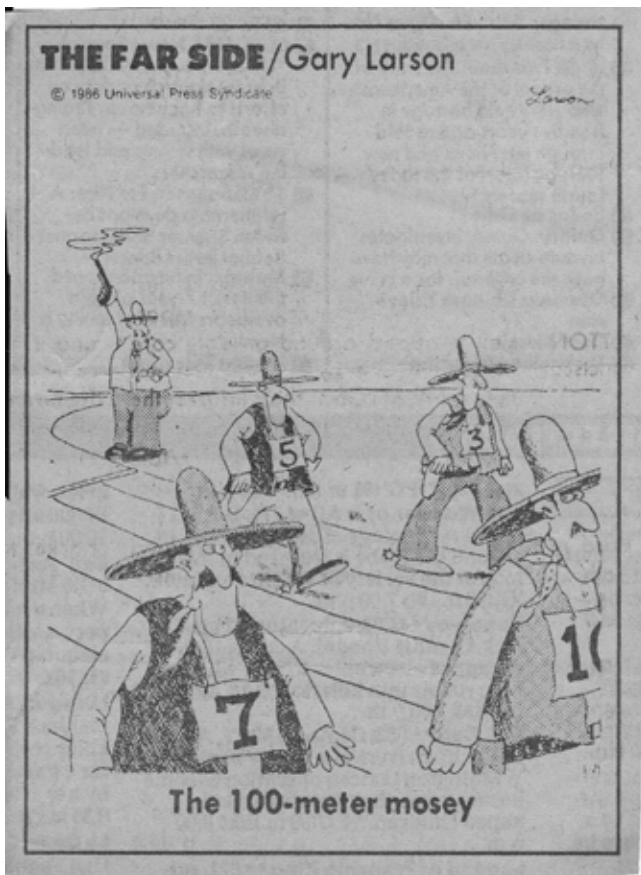

Pick'n Pot Luck Recipe

Avocado Pasta Salad

16oz large shell pasta
1 California Avocado, diced
1 1/2 cups grape tomatoes, halved
6 strips thick cut bacon, cooked and crumbled
2 tablespoons fresh basil, ribboned
(optional) 1-2 cups cooked chicken, cubed or shredded

For the Dressing:

1 cup ranch dressing
1 California Avocado
1 lime, juice of
1/4 cup chopped cilantro
1/4 tsp salt

Prepare the pasta according to package directions. Once tender, drain the pasta and run cold water throughout to cool the pasta down. Place in a large bowl.

Prepare the dressing by adding all the dressing ingredients to a blender and process until smooth. Pour over the cooled pasta and toss to coat.

Fold in the diced avocado, grape tomatoes, bacon, basil (and chicken if desired.) Season with additional salt and pepper if desired. Enjoy!
